SEASON	APPLICATION	PURPOSE
CYCLE 1 February- March	First blanket of pre-emergent for crabgrass and other weeds. Broadleaf weed control	To Prevent troublesome and ugly weeds from sprouting. Helps get grass ready for Spring.
CYCLE 2 April- May	Green-up Golf course quality fertilizer. Second pre-emergent for late season crab grasses Broadleaf weed control- Surface insect control-if necessary. *	Jump-starts the lawn. Enhances color and prevents ugly weeds from germinating. Helps keep unwanted insects from damaging the lawn.
CYCLE 3 May- June	A special formulated fertilizer containing nitrogen, iron, and other nutrients to give your lawn a nice green color-surface insect control.*	Maintain enhanced color with controlled released fertilizer. Helps continue to keep weeds and unwanted insects out of the landscape.
CYCLE 4 July-August	A special formulated fertilizer containing nitrogen, iron, and other nutrients to give your lawn a nice green color. Weed ma	Maintain enhanced color with controlled release fertilizer. Helps continue to keep lawn free of weeds and insects. Iron for Color.
CYCLE 5 August-October	Pre-winter root feeding with a super-high potassium application for winter root development-Surface insect control*- Weed Management	To help recover from summer stress and force roots to grow down for winter survival. Continue to keep lawn free of weeds and insects. Iron for Color.
CYCLE 6 December-January	Blanket of fall pre-emergent to prevent winter weeds. Surface insect control*- Check pH level and add Dolomitic lime (if needed)	To prevent winter broadleaf weeds. Continue to keep lawn free of weeds and insects. Lime will promote green up next year for low acid soils now.
